Ask for evidence if in any doubt Ensure tools used are fit for purpose and in good order Wear footwear with good grip Take care when moving around, especially on uneven ground or around potential trip hazards Wear fluorescent jacket if in public areas. Beware of sharp or corrosive materials and wear gloves to protect hands at all times. Wear full PPE equipment as necessary e.g. helmet, protective boots, protective glasses etc. Do not climb on to unstable surfaces or climb without appropriate access equipment. E.g. ladders. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briefing and risk assessments carried out to stress the nature of the risks and the care needed.
